



The Clear Lake, Texas plant manufactures products widely used in the manufacture of personal care and household products including such items as disposable diapers, hand lotion, detergent, shampoo, acrylic yarn, and water-based acrylic coatings, as well as water treatment chemicals. The site is also home to the U.S. headquarters for the Acrylics Business Unit.

The plant manufactures three products described below.

- We use a process that reacts propylene (hydrocarbon gas) with air to produce acrylic acid. The plant runs year-round on a 24-hour schedule.
- \rightarrow We use a process that combines acrylic acid with butanol (butyl alcohol) to produce butyl acrylate.
- → We use a process that combines acrylic acid with methanol (methyl alcohol) to produce methyl acrylate.
